

S'Alova.

Who can book the scout hostels?

Any entity, formal or informal group can go to the scout hostels, which means that associations, families and individuals can all enjoy them. The 'Entity name' field is for the name of the group or association or the name of the representative of the people going. The name appearing in this field is that which will appear on the bill issued by the Maria Ferret Foundation.

Why can't I book a property 4 days before I enter?

Although the site is not permitted, this shelter can we make exceptions because there is no technical for coming the property to open and close. Therefore depends only on the user or interested party that may pass through the secretariat of the Foundation to come to find the key.

It is important that the user has already paid for when it comes to keys.

How do I get to the property? Can I get there by car?

A description of each property that is on the booking page there is a link with Googlemaps. A S'Alova can not reach the property by car. In Biniaraix can leave the car there and then follow the path of Biniaraix ravine, approximately 30-40 minutes (depending of each group). The secretariat of the Foundation may request a small sketch of the road you will arrive safely.

How far is it to the beach?

The nearest beaches are S'Alova is the Sóller port. To get there on foot is approximately 1h 30min (is down, it takes longer to return).

Do I have to go and collect the key or will someone come to open up?

By the time we confirm your booking, once confirmed we received your payment, you receive an email telling you that you can go secretariat for the key. When you sell, you must sign a sheet indicating that the key is lifted and the day that the return must also sign the same sheet to reflect that you return it.

Will my group be alone on the property?

Yes. S'Alova is a small property and there can be only one group.

Why do I have to pay for a minimum number of places?

There will only be one group in each area of the property, camping area or house-refuge. In other words, the property may be shared, but not the same space. Each space will therefore be for a single group whether it be large or small. To compensate, the Maria Ferret Foundation has established minimum occupancy in each area to guarantee minimum income from each stay, for in the end it is the income from the stays that enable us to restore and improve the properties.

What services do I have if I go to the refuge?

This refuge is a mountain refuge. Has no electricity, water or toilets, toilets and showers. It has a lounge with fireplace is also the space used for sleeping.

What services do I have if I go to the camping area?

Only camping area. The interior of the refuge is not available unless you rent it, and you have to bring your own tents. This area is not a camp site and is therefore not set out in plots.

What is there in the kitchen? Is there cutlery, plates and cups?

In s'Alova no kitchen.

Can I make a fire or a grill? Will there be firewood?

Following the regulations of the Ministry of Environment, between May and September, inclusive, can not fire out. If you reserve the refuge is the best place to do it in the fireplace.

Is there electricity? Can I plug in apparatuses?

In s'Alova no electricity.

Is there water? Is it fit for drinking?

In s'Alova no water.

What are the beds and rooms like? Do we have to take sleeping bags?

In s'Alova no beds or mattresses. To sleep is to do it on the floor of the same room. Should carry a good sleeping bag.

What are the bathrooms like? And the showers?

In s'Alova no bathrooms or showers.

Can we take animals?

If these are guide dogs for the blind or you are alone on the property there will be no problem. In any case, you will be responsible for any damage that might be caused to the property.

Do children also pay?

Yes. Children also pay, unless they are under 3 (not at school age).
